



REGULATIONS OF THE ANNUAL AWARD OF THE PONTIFICAL COUNCIL FOR CULTURE.

- 1 -

The "Per Artem ad Deum" Medal is presented by the Pontifical Council for Culture in recognition of the projects which contribute to the culture and arts development, projects which encourage and strengthen the dialogue between people of different nationalities, projects of a special significance for the theory of society, philosophy, law or religion thus can be regarded role model projects.

- 2 -

Candidates recommended for the Award Chapter assessment are persons whose achievements significantly contribute towards development of art and culture in such areas as: knowledge, literature and all kinds of literature genres, arts, philosophy and systems of values and attitude. The laureates of the previous editions of the Pontifical Council for Culture Medal "Per Artem ad Deum" cannot be presented as candidates for the Award.

- 3 -

A candidate can be presented with the award in recognition of undertaking realisations if these undertakings fulfil the following criteria:

- ❖ concern substantial culture-development problems from the point of view of social theory, culture, history, law or religion, constitute a section of human metaphysics and at the same time may set an example to others;



- ❖ participate in the ethical image creation / religious values dissemination;
- ❖ in their activities the candidates are rooted in ethics as the theory of moral conduct and aesthetics as the value of artistic creation.

- 4 -

The following mode of candidate nomination has been established:

- ❖ Candidates for the competition may nominated by: Unions, Associations, Artistic Organizations and other organisations, representatives of churches, Higher Education Institutions and Universities, Higher Theological Seminaries as well as social and cultural organizations, media representatives and individuals.
- ❖ Nominations should be submitted as a completed Nomination Form and sent in an electronic form to the following e-mail address: nagroda@targikielce.pl or by regular post to the following address: Targi Kielce SA, Secretariat of the Pontifical Council for Culture Award, 25-672 Kielce, 1, Zakładowa St., Poland.
- ❖ No charge imposed for submitting the recommendation.
- ❖ The nominations should be submitted no later than 30 December 2018 (determined by the delivery date). Submission of the recommendation for Annual Award shall be deemed the acceptance of the Rules and Regulations.

- 5 -

The Competition resolution:



- ❖ The Candidates who meet the formal and substantive requirements of the Annual Award of the Pontifical Council for Culture - the "Per Artem ad Deum" Medal shall be assessed by the Chapter. Having thoroughly considered all the justifications supported with the attached materials, the Chapter will perform the initial selection of no more than 5 candidates.
- ❖ The Pontifical Council for Culture is presented with the list of nominees; the Council audits the Candidates presented and approves the nominations.
- ❖ From among the nominees, the President of the Pontifical Council for Culture HE Cardinal Gianfranco Ravasi selects one laureate or a number of laureates.
- ❖ The selection of laureates made by the President of the Pontifical Council for Culture is an autonomous decision of final character and cannot be appealed against or charged.

- 6 -

Distinctions:

- ❖ The award is of an honorary nature.
- ❖ The Laureate will have the possibility of presenting their achievements during the SACROEXPO exhibition (i.e. in a form of an exhibition, concert, lecture etc. ...)
- ❖ The Laureate is granted with the right to use the title of the Laureate of "Per Artem ad Deum" Medal as well as the graphic representation of the Annual Award - the "Per Artem ad Deum" Medal of the Pontifical Council for Culture in their own materials.
- ❖ The Organisers will provide European media with information concerning the Laureates and their achievements



- ❖ The Laureate is presented the Annual Award at the gala ceremony held on 10 June 2019 during the SACROEXPO in Targi Kielce.

- 7 -

Personal Data Protection

The personal data of the entities which have submitted the recommendation and the data of nominees, hereinafter referred to as Participants are processed in order to organise the proceedings and the awarding ceremony.
